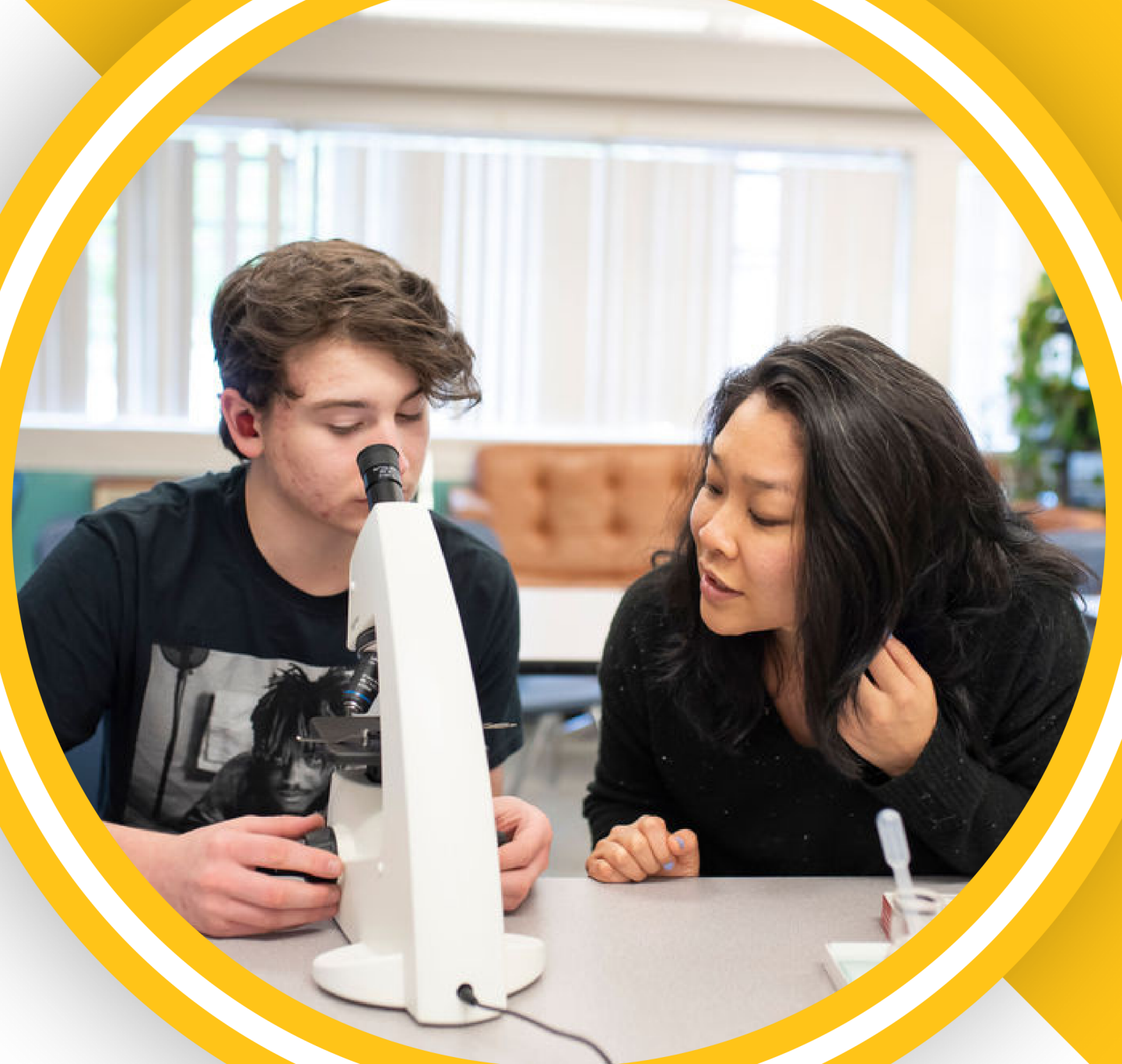

# Underdiagnoses and lack of resources

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Challenges parents and caregivers of a child with learning differences can be multi-fold, including: lack of access to professional diagnoses and under-resourced schools that cannot provide the critical supports their child needs to thrive.

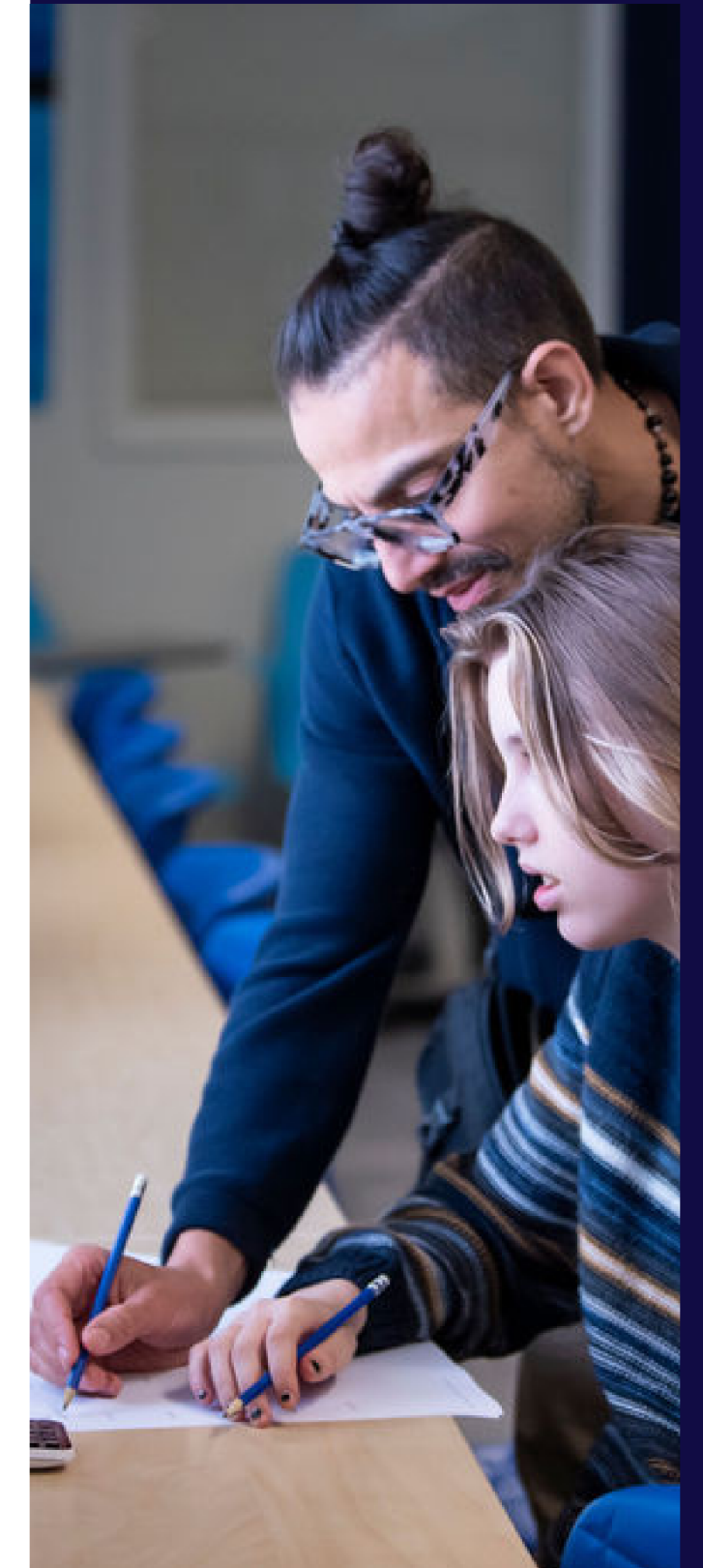
### LACK EARLY IDENTIFICATION

Missing early identification can negatively impact an individual's self-confidence, academic and life trajectory. Early evidenced-based interventions significantly reduce these impacts.

24%

### LACK OF SCHOOL RESOURCES

24% of parents caring for a child with a diagnosed or suspected learning difference reported that their child was excluded from academic learning available to their peers. Either because they were asked to leave early or there was a lack of school resources.
